What is the Rx Discount?

It provides our plan members significant savings through the use of their ID card. At the point of sale, members simply present their ID card at any Walmart or Sam's Club pharmacy nationwide, and the discount is instantly applied. It's that easy!

What ID Card Should I Use?

First Ameritas dental, eye care and hearing care plan members may present their original First Ameritas ID card, or the Rx discount savings ID card available online. The identifier is the First Ameritas logo. To get the online-only Rx discount savings ID card, members may visit firstameritasgroup.com and sign into (or create) their secure member account.

Who Needs Discount Prescription Drugs?

Anyone with limited or no prescription drug plan can benefit. Instead of paying full price for medication, members and their covered dependents (even their pets) can save money on prescription drugs.

Members who already have an existing pharmacy benefit may still see savings on medications that are not included in their plan.
